NEWFOUNDLAND CARAVAN JULY 7-28, 2009

We will meet in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and take in some sights. From there, we'll drive to Cape Breton Island to board the ferry for our crossing to Newfoundland. We will spend several days in St John's, Newfoundland, sightseeing in the "Oldest City in North America", and will visit Cape Spear, the Eastern most point in North America. On our way to the "West Coast" we'll visit the picturesque towns of Trinity, Bonavista and Twillingate where we hope to see some huge icebergs. Then, it's on to Rocky Harbor and the Gros Morne National Park. From there, we head to L'Anse Aux Meadows where the Vikings landed in approximately 1000AD. We'll explore the Norstead Viking Village. On the way to Nova Scotia we'll visit CornerBrook, the second largest city in

Newfoundland and Rose Blanche, home of the only lighthouse in the world restored from ruins. We will spend the night in Baddeck, and experience a ceilid (Gaelic for Kitchen Party) complete with local musicians providing Cape Breton (Scottish) music. We hope you are amongst the first members to enjoy this caravan.

GOOD NEWS! When we initially priced the Newfoundland trip the Canadian and U.S. Dollar were about on par. Also fuel prices were at their peak and the surcharge being charged by the ferry was at 27%. That is now considerably lower. The surcharge is reviewed quarterly and could go up or down. We do not, however, anticipate a return to last year's high. **We are going to reduce the price by \$250 to \$3440 per coach at this time.**

Kountry Klub's Rhine/Moselle River Cruise October 10-17

Our ship is the beautiful 5 Star "MV Heidelberg". As she carries only 110 passengers your cruise will be an intimate journey that gives you an opportunity to interact with your fellow passengers. Each cabin has two lower beds, all are outside with private shower/toilet and many other amenities. River cruising has several advantages, not the least of which is smooth waters all the time so seasickness is never an issue. When the vessel docks you are right in the heart of quaint villages and towns which makes exploring and

shopping very easy. The cruise begins in Cologne, Germany and sails south (up the Rhine) to Rudesheim, Mainz, and through the Lorelei Passage to Koblenz at the confluence with the Moselle River. Now traveling west you will see Cochem, Bernkastel and Trier where you will disembark. These are the most scenic areas of these rivers where you will visit quaint towns, vineyards, castles and fortresses. Traveling in October should also provide vibrant Fall Colors. Edgerton's Travel has negotiated very attractive rates for the

Kountry Klub which helps to ease the pain of the low value of the dollar. Prices begin at only \$1,899/person which includes the cruise, all meals and entertainment, taxes and fuel surcharges and even 5 shore excursions.
