



And as a reminder, if you did not sign up and want to be contacted to be on the standby list, call or email the Klub Office. There is no cost to be on the standby list and you have the option of accepting an opening or rejecting it if you cannot add it to your plans.

Plans for the 2022 International Rally are well underway and information is available in this edition of the magazine. Our plan was to have information available before now, however we experienced extreme delays in getting vendor information and commitments. Many are reluctant to give us quotes or contracts with so many unknowns regarding the economy and pandemic. Several were unable to obtain resources they previously were able to access in order to meet our needs. We can understand their caution but find it very frustrating to do our job as we would like. We would have liked to have not had to raise the cost, but we are no different from any other business in today's world. We have no avenue to absorb cost increases as our International Rally must support itself. We have made a concerted effort to make some adjustments to keep the increase as low as possible. We cannot guarantee there will not be changes to our plans, but we will concentrate on making the International Rally a special event that continues to be rewarding and worthwhile. We hope you will join us and register right away.

We are pleased to announce that NIRVC will be the displaying unit dealer at the 2022 International Rally. We will also have IWS Sales in attendance as the displaying dealer for the Super C models.

We announced in the Happenings newsletter that the 2023 International Rally will be held in Sedalia, Missouri. We visited the grounds last fall and were pleased to find that they now have 1,200 upgraded 50-amp full hookup sites. And most are on level ground! This location was extremely limited in the timeframes they can offer us. Thus, **the 2023 rally will be held beginning September 30 through October 7, 2023. Mark your calendars, make your plans and plan to join us in the most central area of the United States.**

Because of our ability to travel, we can look forward to a spring whenever we want. Like the buds on the trees and flowers, may you find peace, contentment and joy budding wherever you go.

2022 INTERNATIONAL *Rally Information*

REGISTRATION

This year all sites will have 50 amp FHU and there are approximately 600 sites available. Basic rally fee includes Saturday arrival. You will also have the option of Friday arrival. Registration should be done on line www.newmarkcountryklub.com and will open at 8:00 am eastern time on Monday, February 7, 2022. If you prefer you can complete the registration forms found within this issue and mail or fax your reservation to the office. Sorry but we cannot take any phone reservations for the International Rally.

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION

This year's early bird deadline is Friday, May 13, 2022. If your reservation is received by that day you will be included in the drawing to have your basic rally fee refunded held during Opening Ceremonies. So, get those forms in early!

HANDICAP MEMBERS

If you applied for handicap parking we will need a copy of your mirror hang tag or photo of license plate sent or emailed to us to complete your reservation. If you're in a wheelchair accessible unit please indicate this on the registration form so we can ensure you have the added space needed.

RALLY CONFIRMATION PACKET

Within approximately two weeks of registering you will receive a confirmation packet in the mail. Included in the packet is your color-coded parking card, directions/general information, and a yellow envelope with the service request form. If not received or lost, please email or call the Klub office and we will send out a new packet as this parking card must be in your windshield when arriving.

BOONDOCKING

We will be offering boondocking (no power or hookups) on Thursday, July 14 or on Friday, July 15 with arrival prior to 6:00 pm. Cost for boondocking will be \$10 cash per night and collected upon arrival. If you plan to boondock please indicate that on your reservation forms for pre-planning purposes. Please be sure to follow the directions within your rally packet for boondock parking and posted signs. If boondocking, please stay away from the rally area so we can complete rally preparations.

EXTRA HOSES, CORDS AND LEVELING MATERIAL NEEDED

The sewer, water and electric hookups are on average forty feet from your unit. Be sure to have extra hoses and electric cords. Another item to note is that although many sites are quite level, some will require material to assure a comfortable, level site.

PARKING/LATE ARRIVAL

This year's location is unique as you will be staged and parked by the length of your unit to size of sites. You will also need to unhook any tow behind trailers and they will be parked close to your unit. **Please have your color-coded parking card and Klub number decal displayed in your windshield** upon arrival to help the parkers get you staged. Note: If you arrive after 4:00 pm you will be held in the staging area and parked the next morning.

SERVICE AT INTERNATIONAL RALLY

Within your reservation packet you will receive a Service Request form in a yellow envelope. Be sure to fill out the form and return to the service department by their deadline date. If you do not have time to mail by that date, bring paperwork to the rally and you will be processed as non-registered.

The service department once again wants to emphasize the benefits and importance of preregistering. First, preregistering often allows the techs to bring your needed parts to the rally; second, preregistering allows priority

service check-in beginning the first morning; those who are not preregistered will report later that morning to register for service work.

In order to service as many customers as possible during the rally, the Service Department will prioritize their service in the following sequence:

1. Emergency customers will be serviced first. Emergency items are ONLY items that would prevent a coach from leaving the rally or render a coach uninhabitable.
2. Warranty customers will be serviced in order of date of purchase, beginning with the most recent.
3. Out-of-warranty customers will also be serviced in order of date of purchase, beginning with the most recent. Newmar will offer this service at a reduced service rate.

PARTS DEPARTMENT

The Parts Department will bring an inventory of the more popular parts for you to purchase during the rally. Remember, if they do not have the part at the rally you can order it for later delivery.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR THE RALLY

Within this issue you will see a listing of areas we need help with. Not only will you be helping your fellow Klub members but it's a great way to meet new friends. Email or call the Klub office (kountryklub@newmarcorp.com or 877-639-5582), and we'll be glad to sign you up. Contact person indicated or if you prefer you can register at the rally after reviewing the rally program. Don't forget your Region Directors and the Fulltimers' Chapter are also looking for volunteers; please contact them direct for information on their duties.

RALLY AREA TOURS

This year area tours will be offered thru the Sweetwater County Travel and Tourism Center. They will provide a day-long bus tour of the Flaming Gorge area July 11 or July 12, 2022. **To register see their advertisement on page 46. You will need to make arrangements to arrive at least one day prior to your scheduled tour at the fairgrounds directly with the Sweetwater Event Center by calling 307-352-6789.** This will be in an area away from our parking and rally set-up. **On the rally arrival day and time frame per your rally paperwork you will then move to our staging area to be parked for the rally.** This arrangement for early area tour dates will allow our members to attend activities on the Saturday and Sunday of the beginning of our event.

An independent drive and walk tour through historic Rock Springs will be available anytime during your visit. Maps will be available at registration or you can download maps for your phone or tablet on their website.

RECEIVING MAIL AT THE RALLY

You can have mail sent to you during the rally. Please use this address for any mail or packages: your name and Klub #, Newmar Kountry Klub Rally, c/o Sweetwater Events Complex, 3320 Yellowstone Road, Rock Springs, WY 82901. Please have it marked "Hold for Pickup". Mailed should not be delivered before July 14th. Any items received after the rally will be returned to sender.

PHONE APP/POSTING OF RALLY PROGRAM

We will once again be using the phone app **GRUPIO** for your convenience viewing the rally schedule. We will have the app available in early July as well as posting the Rally Program to our website. More information will be added to future magazine issues as well as the Happenings email newsletter.

Well here it is 2022! We do have a full lineup of great special events to keep you on the road this year exploring this great country of ours. Several of these scheduled in spring and early summer have already opened for reservations, and we are pleased to say most are close to selling out. Remember we always have a standby list to use to fill cancellations so if you want to go on one of these drop us an email kountryklub@newmarcorp.com or give us a call 877-639-5582, and we will add you to the list. See the Klub Calendar in this issue and on our website newmarkountryklub.com for a list of events scheduled at this time.

And, speaking of 2022 and upcoming events, this issue is the one with all the details of the 36th International Rally. We will be in a new location this year, the Sweetwater Events Complex in Rock Springs, Wyoming. Basic rally dates will be Saturday, July 16-Saturday July 23 with the option of early arrival on Friday the 15th. One big plus is all sites are 50 FHU this year. Registration opens thru our website on Monday, February 7th. We will have 600 sites available; it sure would be great for this event to become sold out also!

A few items to note on this year's rally:

- **An Early Pre-Rally Tour of the Flaming Gorge National Recreation area will be offered direct thru the visitors/tourism office on the Monday or Tuesday before the rally.** See the ad on page 46 for all the details and registration information. You will need to arrive one day before your scheduled tour date and can **contact the Sweetwater Events Complex to arrange early arrival.** They will park you in an area away from what will be used for the rally. We do ask that you respect our request to stay away from the campgrounds and buildings we will be setting up while you are there early.
- **Freightliner will be offering their 2-day Camp Freightliner classes on Saturday & Sunday after our rally.** You will need to register for the classes on Freightliner's website, see ad on page 68, and again you'll need to contact the Sweetwater Events Complex to arrange to extend your rally stay to accommodate the classes.
- **We do need to bring to your attention** that the water/power hookups will be approximately 40 feet from your unit. Be sure to have the needed extra amount of cords/hoses to accommodate this. The area will not be as hilly as West Virginia was but some sites may require a few leveling blocks, again please be prepared for this situation.

Have you seen the two early announcements on events for 2023? We have released the dates and location for the **37th International Rally – it will be in Sedalia, Missouri from September 30-October 7.** More details on the 2023 International Rally will be shared later this year. And secondly, we announced we will be hosting an **Alaskan Cruise, dates will be July 30-August 6.** Registration for the cruise opened about a month ago direct with the cruise coordinator, and at least one category of rooms is already sold out. See the cruise ad on page 52 & 53 and on our website for how to get more information and to register.

KOUNTRY KORNER RECIPES

CHICKEN SPAGHETTI SPOLETO. WE CALL IT WHITE SPAGHETTI.

1 cup green pepper strips.
1/4 cup melted butter
1- pkg. tangy Kraft Spaghetti Italian Style. (Green box) usually by the boxed Kraft macaroni

2-tblsp. Flour
2- cups milk
2-cup chopped chicken or Turkey. I used a large can of chicken.

Sauté green peppers in butter, blend in the herb spice mix from the Kraft box and flour. Gradually add milk. Cool stirring constantly till thickened. I sometimes add more milk. To have more white sauce. Add chicken and simmer 10 minutes. Prepare spaghetti as directed on package. Pour sauce over spaghetti, sprinkle with grated Parmesan cheese.

INSTANT POT CREAMY SUN DRIED TOMATO CHICKEN

Instant Pot cooking is perfect for the RV. Never heats up the kitchen and easy to make.

Ingredients
1 1/2 - 2 lbs. chicken thighs (boneless skinless)
2 tsp smoked paprika
Salt
Ground black pepper
3 tablespoon unsalted butter
3 cloves garlic, minced
1 cup chicken broth
1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
1/2 cup sun dried tomatoes with its oil
8 oz fresh sliced mushrooms
2 cups baby spinach
2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

INSTRUCTIONS

Season both sides of the chicken thighs with the smoked paprika, salt and pepper.

Press sauté on the Instant Pot and melt 2 tablespoons of the butter. Working in batches, place the chicken thighs in the Instant Pot and cook until browned on both sides, about 3 minutes each side. Remove to a plate.

Add the remaining 1 tablespoon of butter and let it melt. Add the garlic and stir until fragrant, about 30-45 seconds. Stir in the chicken broth and deglaze the pot.

Add the chicken back into the Instant Pot, add sun dried tomatoes and mushrooms. Place the lid on the pot and lock. Select high pressure for 7 minutes.

Once the timer goes off, allow a natural release for 3 minutes, then quick release.

Press sauté on the instant pot. Take 2 tablespoons of the heavy cream and whisk it with the cornstarch in a small bowl. Whisk the remaining cream into the Instant Pot, followed by the cornstarch mixture. Cook, whisking often, until it has lightly thickened. Stir in the Parmesan cheese until melted, then stir in the spinach and allow it to cook until wilted. Taste and season with salt and pepper. Turn off the Instant Pot.

Serve the chicken thighs on top of pasta, if desired. Sprinkle the chicken with parsley before serving.

We will all have 50 amp full hookup this year. The amenities are approximately 40 feet from the units so please arrive with the necessary additional electric cords, water hoses and sewer connections. City water is available to all coaches. Some water hookups are shared and **NOT** designated for one unit. **Remember to bring a "Y" so you can take water on as needed. Also some sites may need a little blocking material to level your unit.**

If you wish to park with a friend, you must have the same arrival date and arrive together. The parking team will do their best to park you together. All caravans (4 or more units) must be registered with the Klub Office as a caravan and arrive together at your designated time.

Anyone arriving after 4:00 PM on parking days will be held in the staging area and will be parked the next morning.

MEMBER ADVENTURES

Member's (UN)Adventure *Fall From Grace*

No, we haven't named our 2005 Mountain Aire "Grace," but that might be appropriate. I fell off a ladder climbing onto her roof. I survived. You might not.

We had been on the road for six wonderful months before, well, let's just say that this must become a cautionary tale, my friends.

This had become the season of our discontent. A comedy of errors began in Virginia Beach. After a beautiful bumper-to-bumper factory paint job for the entire motorhome last spring, I forced the left side of our fresh bus to become intimate with a hard-as-steel dead-end sign near the beach—the result of an unexpected road repair detour. But that was just a warm-up.

We returned for the winter to our little marina condo in SW Florida this October to take care of some non-RV business—you know, the normal stuff Earthlings do—to see doctors and such. If we only knew then! We try to return here for a few months at least every couple of years.

We spent our first long day at home uneventfully "moving ashore," that is, from motorhome to condo (can you tell we used to live aboard a boat?) But the very next day turned out to be much more, ah, (mis)adventurous.

I backed the 43' coach into our condo building's small parking lot. And I almost didn't notice the large palm tree shudder in the rear camera's monitor on the dash. But it did. I crushed my ladder. Home for less than twenty-four hours, and I'm still just warming up.

So my fresh paint is scratched down to the fiberglass, and my tail cap's ladder is pulverized. I'm nevertheless still ready to wash the old girl's roof. Now close to my source of water, with my hose and bucket at the ready, I know enough not to trust the damaged RV ladder, so I retrieve my heavy-duty twelve-foot ladder from the garage. I ensured a solid two points of contact at the top, and the same at the bottom—the ladder's rubber feet rest on dry and level asphalt, set at a conservative angle. What could go wrong?

My climb to the roof with hose and empty bucket hooked on my arm, using both hands to climb, all goes well. I reach the roof and carefully plant the bucket up top. No problem. The RV's roof is now level with my chest as I perch on that substantial aluminum ladder, preparing to mount the roof. And then...

The ladder drops. It does not tip backwards. It does not slip. The world just disappears beneath my feet. For the better part of twelve feet, anyway. Next thing, I'm flat on my back, the ladder is laying by my right side, still fully extended, and my right foot is still tangled in its treads.

Barely conscious, I take stock. Right hip burns like Dante's deepest circle of hell. Same with my back—broken? Well, I can move my feet, the left one anyway. My arms and fingers work. So no broken back. Hip, maybe. Yup. Everything hurts, a lot. They'd tell me later, "full-body trauma," whatever that means. We can guess, can't we?

Oh, did I mention that after my fall from Grace, when I found the pocket where my cell phone hid, I called Kay who had run to the store for provisions. I said, "I fell. I think I broke my back," which is not how you safely inspire a loved one to run to your aid when she's driving a 300HP Jeep. The fire engine and ambulance beat her to me only because she suffered a flat tire in our two-year-old vehicle! Excessive speed might have been partially an issue.

So, after just one day at home, I've now set the tone for the entire winter. I am fortunate to have fractured only a single bone—my right heel—the slowest-healing bone in human anatomy. Maybe worst of all, I've forced my sweet bride of fifty-two years to be a full-time caregiver for several months. I try, but with only one usable leg, I'm limited. And I'm determined not to do anything ELSE stupid this winter, like put weight on my right foot before that eggshell heals.

Three months in a cast, another month or two in a walking boot, including a couple of months of physical terrorism? I am so done with ALL LADDERS. At least I live to share with you this cautionary tale.

For those of you who think it's still okay to climb ladders? Your mileage may vary, but take it from me, at a youthful seventy-two years of age (I was indoor skydiving in Virginia Beach a month earlier), just write a check to hire someone. Or you could be inviting your own season of discontent.

What happened to my ladder? It's a mystery, but it could ONLY involve the extension mechanism. Fortunately, nobody is calling for an investigation. I don't really want to know. Call me a sublime ostrich, if you wish. I'm movin' on.



CHARGING HOUSE AND/OR CHASSIS BATTERIES

This article provides the Newmar-recommended instructions for charging dead house or chassis batteries.

NOTICE

The following instructions are generic to Newmar coaches and are NOT specific to your coach. They should only be used as a reference guide for this process, as power components may vary by coach.

IF SHORE POWER IS AVAILABLE:

Plug the coach into shore power and make sure the inverter charger is turned on and that the inverter shows bulk charge. The batteries should charge unless the inverter is in fault mode or if the voltage is below 9.8 volts on coaches equipped with SilverLeaf. If the chassis battery bank is still holding a charge, it may be possible to press and hold the battery boost switch in order to get the house battery voltage high enough for the low voltage disconnect to engage. If not, manual charging may be necessary to charge the batteries.

IF SHORE POWER IS NOT AVAILABLE:

If the coach is equipped with a battery boost switch on the dash, press and hold it in order to connect the battery banks together to try and start the engine or generator.

- If the generator or engine starts, it may be possible to charge the battery banks using the Magnum or Xantrex inverter/charger. However, if this fails, it may be necessary to manually charge the batteries.
- If the coach batteries are dead and will not start the engine or generator, or if the house lights and other functions inside the coach are dead, you will need to recharge either the house batteries and/or the chassis batteries.

BATTERY CHARGING

When batteries have a very low state of charge (dead) or are at or below 9.8 volts (on coaches equipped with SilverLeaf), the Magnum or Xantrex system will not engage to charge the batteries when plugged into shore power or when running the generator.


- Connect a high amperage battery charger (preferably 30 amp or higher) to the house battery bank and/or the chassis batteries. Depending on the model of coach, age, and condition of the batteries, the necessary charging time will vary. Follow the inspection procedure prior to charging.

INSPECT THE BATTERIES (DON'T CHARGE A BAD BATTERY)

Perform the following procedure prior to charging:

1. Check the fluid level (if applicable).
 - If the battery type is lead acid with removable caps, check the fluid level to be sure they are full before charging.


- If the battery type is AGM or sealed, do not add fluid.
2. Inspect the battery casing.
 - If it is bulging, leaking, or cracked, do not charge damaged batteries!
 - If necessary, replace any damaged batteries.
3. Turn off or unplug any 12 VDC devices that may have been left on that may have discharged the batteries.
4. Check for odor near the batteries.
 - If a foul odor is present, the batteries may be damaged from overcharging or from charging without adequate fluid. In this case, load-test the batteries if damage is suspected.
 - Inspect and replace any damaged batteries before charging.
5. If the batteries are severely discharged, they will not pass a load test and/or hydrometer test.
 - In this case, the batteries will have to be charged first, then tested.
6. Check the battery connections at the house and chassis batteries.
 - Inspect the battery connections for corrosion and tight connections.
 - If the connections are corroded or loose, clean and tighten the connections.
 - Check for proper battery wiring. The connections can be found on a label typically located beside the battery bank on the tray or on an opposing wall.
 - The battery wiring should match the label.



CHARGING THE HOUSE BATTERY BANK

After the battery inspection is complete, connect the battery charger to the house battery bank.

1. Connect the red and black cables from the charger to the battery bank.
 - Connect the red clamp from the charger to the red (+/positive) battery post on the corner of the battery bank.
 - Connect the black clamp from the charger to the black (-/negative) battery post on the opposite corner of the battery bank.



2. Once connected to the house battery bank, look at the charger.

- If it has a voltmeter gauge or needle, read the voltage. If it shows 12.2 volts or above, the battery bank charge is likely not an issue.
 - In the following example, the white arrow shows the green needle at 12.2 VDC, so this battery bank is OK.



NOTE: Depending on the brand and model of charger being used, it may not need to be plugged into 120 VAC to read the battery bank state of charge.

3. If the bank of 6 volt batteries (hooked up in series parallel) is showing less than 11.5 VDC, plug the charger into a 120 volt outlet, and set the timer to charge the bank (if applicable).

4. After battery charging is complete, test the batteries for dead or weak cells using a load-tester or hydrometer. Hydrometer testing only applies to lead acid batteries. After charging the house battery bank on a coach equipped with SilverLeaf, it may be necessary to reset the inverter(s):

1. Press and hold the reset button on the side of the Xantrex inverter(s) for several seconds.
2. It may also be necessary to reset the TM102 module. Pull the F1 fuse on the KIB module board, and then reinstall it after a few seconds. This module is normally located in the cord compartment or nearby (refer to the SilverLeaf layout print for the coach year and model).



CHARGING THE CHASSIS BATTERY BANK

1. Inspect and test the chassis batteries in the same manner as the house batteries to see if they are damaged or require additional charging.

2. Connect the leads to the chassis batteries, and read the voltage on the charger.

- If 12.2 VDC or higher, the issue is likely not the chassis battery for engine cranking issues.
- If below 11.5 VDC, plug in the charger and begin charging the battery/batteries.

GEMSTONE VANITY SINK REMOVABLE DRAIN COVER OVERVIEW

This article provides the purpose of a vanity sink drain cover and instructions for removing the cover to use or clean the sink drain.

PURPOSE OF THE DRAIN COVER


Some styles of Gemstone solid surface vanity sinks, such as the C1316-V model, are manufactured to include a covered drain for aesthetic purposes. Once removed, this cover is optional and can be put back in or left out of the sink based on user preference. Water simply drains around the edges of the plate, down the drain, and to the waste water tank(s).

The solid surface drain cover is not provided by Gemstone. It is manufactured by Newmar at the time of coach production.



REMOVING THE DRAIN COVER

To remove the drain cover, lightly press on one side of the cover until the other side tilts up enough to grasp it and remove it. If unable to tilt the cover using your fingers, insert a dull, narrow object (such as a butter knife or hook tool) beneath the cover to help pry it up enough to grasp it and remove it. Be careful not to scratch or mar the surface of the sink or cover.



USING THE POP-UP DRAIN

Once the cover is removed, the pop-up style drain can be utilized.

1. Push on the drain to close it (seals sink to hold water).
2. Push on the drain to open it (opens sink to drain water).



CAUTION

This style of sink does NOT have an overflow to release water when the drain is closed. If water is left running from the faucet, the sink will overflow and may cause damage to the coach and surrounding components.

The totals for these repairs were about \$5000 which bring my overall total to about \$14000 of repairs for a \$6000 investment. To add insult to injury to the warranty company my warranty expires December 13th so you know they were happy campers having to spend this money right before the warranty ended. The next hurdle was do I get a follow-on warranty. My concern is 1 injector had to be replaced I still have 5 more and given my luck, this will become an issue. So, I did get a follow-on extended warranty just to play it safe. Guess this is peace of mind insurance.

All of us “snowbirds or snowflakes” are doing the reservations shuffle. Marcy did all of this and now that I am doing it, I fully appreciate how hard it is. So, to all of you that do the reservations for your travels, my hat is off to you – it is a hard job. For those of you that do not do this, show your appreciation by taking the reservations czar to dinner – they earned it. I still have a few gaps in my reservation calendar, mostly because I can only have so many reservations on the books at a time. So, I will be doing the reservation shuffle till I start heading back to Virginia after I attend the Mid-South Tri-State Rally in early May.






