Why 2027 Is a Model Year Worth a Serious Look

As longtime Newmar owners, you've seen this industry move through cycles. You've lived through periods where availability was tight, customization windows were narrow, and pricing reflected peak demand rather than peak value. We're in a very different moment today and for many buyers, that's a good thing.

The 2027 model year arrives at a time when product maturity, market conditions, and customer choice are more aligned than they've been in years. If you're considering your next Newmar, whether it's your first purchase, a move up, or a move down, there are several reasons 2027 deserves a close look.

A Buyer's Window Still Exists—But It Won't Last Forever

Production across the RV industry has normalized. Newmar has been intentional about pacing builds, protecting quality, and avoiding excess inventory. At the dealer level, however, many partners still have meaningful carryover units alongside new 2027 orders.

What that means for owners is flexibility, both in availability and in value, without sacrificing the craftsmanship and attention to detail you expect from Newmar. As production continues to balance and inventories tighten, that flexibility will narrow.

Simply put: 2027 buyers are benefitting from timing, not shortcuts.

Product Decisions Informed by Owners—Not Trends

One advantage Newmar has always leaned into is listening to its owners. The 2027 lineup continues that approach. Rather than wholesale changes for the sake of newness, the focus has been on refinement, usability, and consistency across models.

Owners asked for:

- More residential interiors
- Cleaner, more intuitive electrical and multiplex systems
- Better serviceability
- Floorplans that reflect how people actually travel today

You'll see that influence throughout the 2027 model year, whether you're looking at gas, diesel, Super C, or luxury Class A offerings.

Technology That Improves Ownership, Not Complexity

Across the lineup, Newmar has continued to refine its electrical architecture and multiplex experience. For many owners, these updates aren't about flashy displays, they're about reliability and ease of use.

Improved control systems, better mobile integration, and more logical placement of serviceable components make daily ownership simpler and longterm maintenance more straightforward. These are the kind of "quiet upgrades" that matter most over years of ownership.

Floorplans That Match How People Travel Today

Another theme that carries into 2027 is intentional simplification. Where it made sense, we streamlined floorplans. Where we saw demand, bunks, dual baths, flexible sleeping and entertaining spaces, we leaned in. As an example, check out our new 4345 and 4545 floorplans on the Ventana, Dutch Star, London Aire, Essex and King Aire. We're looking forward to hearing your feedback.



Whether you're a couple traveling seasonally, a family balancing short trips and extended stays, or an owner thinking about ease of use as priorities change, the 2027 lineup offers clearer choices without overwhelming complexity.

Continuity Matters—Especially for Repeat Owners

For existing Newmar owners, one of the most important advantages of 2027 is continuity. You'll find familiar systems, consistent build practices, and a product philosophy that respects what already works.

At the same time, you'll notice thoughtful improvements in areas that typically draw feedback: materials, finishes, usability, and longterm durability.

Looking Ahead Without Rushing the Decision

The beauty of the current environment is that owners don't have to rush. You can compare model years, explore floorplans in person, and make decisions with more information and fewer compromises. But it's also fair to say this window won't remain open indefinitely. As inventories rebalance and build schedules move forward, choice gives way to allocation, and value conversations shift accordingly.

Hi everyone, my name is Marc and I am the chef for the Garden Aires and Mid-Atlantic Rallies. I do 90% of the cooking at home in advance of our outings and use a food warmer and a griddle for other recipes. My wife Kathy & I are true foodies. My father was a French pastry chef (NYC & Ridgewood NJ (Paris Pastry Shop) and Mom was a gourmet cook. I guess it is in my blood. I typically make 2-3 appetizers, at least 2 main courses with several sides. At our recent Mid-Atlantic Rally, I felt we needed an extra appetizer, so I did some research (while watching the food channel) and came up the below recipe.

Strawberry Balsamic Bruschetta

Marc Burel (24767)



Ingredients

- 1 baguette, cut into 1" slices
- 1/4 cup plus 2 tsp. extra-virgin olive oil, divided
- 2 cups ricotta
- 2 tsp. kosher salt
- 1 tsp. Freshly ground black pepper
- 2 cups strawberries, chopped
- 2 Tbsp. fresh basil, thinly sliced
- Balsamic glaze, for serving

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 400°.
2. Place baguette slices on a medium sheet tray and drizzle or brush with 1/4 cup olive oil. Bake until bread is toasted, about 10 minutes.
3. In a medium bowl, mix ricotta with salt, pepper, and 2 teaspoons oil. Spread each toast generously with ricotta mixture then top with strawberries.
4. Garnish with basil and drizzle with balsamic glaze.

Note: I use olive oil every day and when a recipe says drizzle it typically means that there is significant waste. A few years ago, I bought an olive oil sprayer, they are amazing. You get a much more even coating, you use significantly less oil, and it is much faster, great for spraying a pan or cookie sheet. I love sharing my recipes with people, but I really love watching people enjoy the food I prepare. My cookbook now has over 700 recipes in it and I would be happy to share any of them with you, I can also help with ideas on how to prepare at home and have it safely travel with you. FULLTIMERS CHAPTER

Russell & Kim Zapalac (26992)



The *FullTimers Chapter* has lots of experience living in our RV for months at a time, fully immersing ourselves in the communities we visit. We highly recommend the full-time lifestyle to other NKKers, but there are some things you need to be aware of.

Storage for Seasonal Clothes

& Shoes Full-time living means your wardrobe needs to be very selective. You may not be able to bring clothes for every season with you. Many full-timers use small storage units, or a family member's spare closet to rotate seasonal clothing and shoes. For the clothes you do keep, vacuum storage bags can dramatically compress seldom worn items and free up valuable space inside the coach or in the basement.

Hanging Space vs. Drawer Space On Board The closets in most Class As or Super Cs look generous until you actually try to live out of them. Save your nicer clothes for the closet and fold your casual items. Also hanging shoe pockets and slim stackable bins can help maximize closet floor space.

Kitchen Cabinet Space The kitchen generally works for two people until you factor in the toaster oven, cast iron skillet, and full spice collection. Full-timers who love to cook must decide which appliances they really need. If you bake or cook elaborate meals, a larger galley with deeper cabinets should be on your must-have list.

Overhead Cabinets for Books, Crafts, and Hobbies Books and craft supplies are the quiet space-eaters of full-time RV life. An e-reader can replace dozens of physical books overnight. Crafters should look for coaches with extra overhead storage, since art supplies, yarn, and tools all need a dedicated home.

Basement Compartments The underbelly compartments are some of the most valuable real estate on the coach. Dedicate bays for tools, hoses, chairs, grills, rugs, and those extra boxes of clothes. Labeling and organizing those bays from day one saves enormous frustration later. As small as your coach is, it is amazing what you can lose in those bays.

A Mini Home Office The dining table is a poor substitute for a real workspace. A built-in desk with a monitor shelf, file drawer, and printer space can transform livability for remote workers. Some Newmar floor plans offer a separate office slide-out or rear desk, and others include fold-down trays beside the passenger chair that can hold a laptop and files. Figuring out how you will "work" from the road can be challenging.

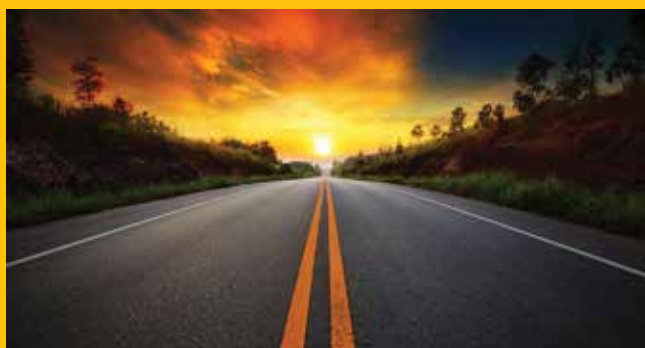

Weekend adventurers. A man named Kevin, wearing a fishing hat and carrying enough questions for an entire college lecture. Within minutes, Cornbread had everybody talking like old friends.

I had traveled enough in life to know there were two kinds of tours. The first kind gave you information. The second kind gave you stories. This was the second kind.

They moved slowly through old stone buildings that had stood since the early 1800s. Cornbread spoke fast, words tumbling over one another as she explained bourbon mash, limestone water, fermentation vats, and the strange miracle of keeping the same yeast alive for over seventy years. But somehow, none of it sounded technical. It sounded personal. Like the buildings themselves were alive.

Inside the fermentation room, steam and heat rolled through the air. Massive wooden vats bubbled like giant cauldrons from another century. Cornbread leaned over one of them and inhaled dramatically.

"Some people smell banana bread," she announced. "I smell a Miller Lite left on a hot beach for four days." The room erupted. Even I laughed harder than expected.

I looked around and realized nobody had their guard up anymore. The people from different states, different lives, different backgrounds — they were all joking together now. Somewhere between the parking lot and the fermenters, strangers had quietly become companions.

Maybe that was the real product being made here. Not bourbon. Connection.

Outside, they crossed a dry-stacked limestone bridge built entirely without mortar. Cornbread explained how gravity and friction alone held it together.

I stopped halfway across and looked down at the creek below. I thought about businesses. About families. About companies built slowly over decades. Maybe the strongest things in life weren't held together by force. Maybe they held together because every piece leaned correctly against the next. The warehouses were darker than I expected. Cooler, too.

Thousands upon thousands of barrels stretched endlessly into shadow. The air smelled sweet, woody, heavy with age. Cornbread ran her hand across one of the barrels almost affectionately. "Consistency," she said. "That's everything here."

She explained how every barrel was hand-rotated through the warehouse over the years, so the flavor remained balanced. Harder work. Slower work. Purposefully inefficient. I smiled at that phrase.

Purposefully inefficient. In a world obsessed with shortcuts, there was something noble about people who still believed some things deserved the long way around.

As we walked deeper through the warehouse, Cornbread kept talking. About bourbon. About history. About trees. About glass art. About warehouse workers strong enough to roll five-hundred-pound barrels all day long.

But underneath the jokes and stories, I heard something else. Pride. Not corporate pride. Raftsmen pride. The kind built by people who still cared whether the work was done right.

Toward the end of the tour, they entered the cellar where special wood staves transformed ordinary bourbon into something richer and more complex. Cornbread held up pieces of charred oak like sacred relics.

"Water and wood," she said. "That's what changes everything." I thought about that longer than I expected. Sometimes the smallest additions changed the entire character of something. A little time. A little pressure. A little fire. And suddenly, what began as ordinary became memorable.

By the time we reached the gift shop, sunlight flooded across the courtyard. The group lingered together instead of immediately leaving. Kevin was still asking questions. Someone else was buying sweaters they probably didn't need. Another couple debated which bottles to dip in the iconic red wax.

Cornbread stood near the entrance, greeting new arrivals with the same energy she had shown hours earlier. I watched her for a moment. Most people never realize the impact they have on strangers.

A good tour guide thinks she's explaining bourbon. A great one reminds people how good life feels when people laugh together.

As I headed back toward the RV lot, the smell of oak and mash still clinging faintly on my clothes, I looked back one final time at the old distillery buildings standing against the Kentucky hills.

Some places make products. Some places make memories. This place somehow managed to do both. I believe the secret formula is Cornbread.

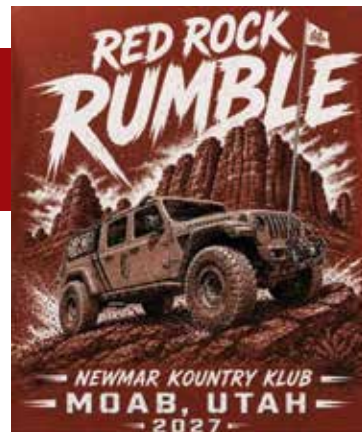
